#### THEATER BUS IS CELEBRATING 50 YEARS!

It's unusual to hear of a small, local nonprofit lasting 50 years, but here we are. Fifty years ago, Theater Bus began as an idea of Ralph Sandler of the Wisconsin union Theater and Miriam Boegel, Community Arts Administrator. They wanted to bring older adults to Union Theater performances, and they approached the West Side Senior Coalition (now part of New Bridge, Madison) to see if they wanted to partner.

By 1976, Theater Bus became an experimental project of the Wisconsin Union Theater and the West Side Senior Coalition. The goal was to increase attendance at the "Young Artists in the Performing Arts" series and to encourage older adults to enjoy events they might not otherwise have access to. The program was an immediate success and per participants requests, other area theater events were added. Ultimately, the Union Theater decided to drop out of the project. In 1977, The Dane County Council of the Arts became a large sponsor. Supporting agencies also included Independent Living, Madison Housing Authority, the Coalition on Aging, the Jewish Community Council, Methodist Retirement Center and Oakwood Village.

In 1979, the Theater Bus board voted to become an independent non-profit organization and incorporation was completed in September of that year. Attic Angel Association provided much of the funding for many years and for a long time Attic Angels residents, served on Theater Bus board. In 1999, Theater Bus received a gift from a participant that enabled Theater Bus to become more financially sound and continue to grow.

The first Theater Bus outing was to the Union Theater to hear the St. Paul Chamber Orchestra on a Saturday morning in February. By 1977, Theater Bus had expanded to serving almost all of Dane county. Though Theater Bus has looked very different through the years, one thing remains the same, the core mission of assisting older adults in having access to theatrical productions in the area.

Fifty years ago, you could see a show and have lunch for \$9.25. Thirty years ago, you could see a Fire-side performance for \$44.00 and for \$2 more you could request pick up at your home. Today, Theater Bus offers pick up locations on the West, South and East sides of town. We travel to at least 36 shows a year and we offer a wide variety of events to appeal to a broader audience.

Theater Bus has always had paid staff. In the beginning it was a full-time Director and a part-time administrative support person. Over time, that became a regular part-time director with volunteers filling in where and when needed. Volunteers continue to handle a lot of the office work, including telephoning, mailing and board decision making. A committee of participants selects the shows that Theater Bus attends. Over 1500 hours are recorded by volunteers annually, though it is certainly much more in reality.

The participants are the core of Theater Bus. They are the reason for Theater Bus's 50 years of success. They are the great encouragers, the primary financial supporters, and the champion volunteers. We look forward to celebrating with you in 2025.

So CHEERS to 50 years of travels and here's to another 50!

#### Please review these important tips:

- We will not contact you to tell you we have received your check. We will only contact you if the trip is full and you are on a waitlist or if the trip is cancelled. If you are on a waitlist, your check will be returned immediately.
- Checks are deposited after the deadline listed in the newsletter. No refunds after the deadline.
- You will get a reminder call from us 2-3 days before the trip.
- Sometimes we have to adjust trip pick up times/locations for construction, weather, etc. PLEASE pay attention when you get your reminder call so that you are aware of any changes. The volunteers that call have the most up to date info. Please listen to your phone messages. If we can't speak to you when we call, we will leave a message with all the information.
- It is **important** that you are able to get up and down the bus steps on your own. Our volunteers are not trained to give any care assistance.
- Registrations will not be taken over the telephone or spaces held unless payment has been received.
- Select the form for the event you wish to attend. Please complete all of the information. (Use a return address label if you have them) Otherwise, print your name and address and telephone number clearly. Please do not assume we will get your information from your check. Sometimes, checks get separated from the registration form. Please complete your name and address. Print CLEARLY.
- Number attending—If you are registering just yourself, enter "1." If you are registering more than one person, write the number attending and then write the name, address, phone number, pickup location, and meal choice, if required, for EACH person.
- The deadline listed on the registration form is the date all checks will be deposited and you no longer will get a refund for cancellation.
- Theater Bus accepts checks, but not credit cards, as payment. **Separate checks must be written for each event.** Checks should be made payable to Theater Bus.
- Mail or drop off your registration form(s) and payment to: Theater Bus, Inc., 437 S. Yellowstone Dr. #214, Madison, WI 53719. If you want to drop off your registration after office hours, we do have a mail slot you can use.
- All tips are included in the cost of the trip, including a tip for the bus driver and wait staff.
- It is *very important* that you bring your cell phone on the trip and keep it with you. We do need a cell phone number on file.
- Please park away from the church and businesses. (Park at the far end of the church lot, etc) We do not want to disrupt funerals at the church or businesses that are open.
