## An Important message from The Board or Directors

Theater Bus is a nonprofit group with the goal of providing trips for everyone at an affordable price. This has become a challenge. As you have realized, the trip prices are now often over \$100 (our historic target maximum price). We are now looking at our entire operation to see how we can adapt while maintaining our goal of affordability. We would like to take this opportunity to explain why and the possible next steps.

As you all know, we are living in a strange time. First it was Covid 19, then the Omicron Variant, supply chain problems, inflation, and now the war in the Ukraine.

We have been affected by the following:

- It has become difficult to find venues to attend. A lot of the Community Theater groups have not reopened. These groups have been the backbone of our trips and usually have the lowest priced trips.
- Other venues, that have opened, have raised their prices as their expenses have risen.
- Restaurants are facing supply and staffing problems.
- Bus companies are having difficulties finding drivers & are still limiting capacity on buses. The cost of fuel is increasing weekly due to the war in the Ukraine.

Bus companies and restaurants are reluctant to guarantee prices months in advance due to food and rising fuel costs. We print newsletters 2 -4 months in advance. There have been some add-ons and surcharges that have been unexpected.

One example of the challenge Ruth, our director and your board are facing is that we have realized our traditional model of calculating trip costs, is not working. We have historically been able to price trips based on 37 participants. This means that on a typical trip, additional participants have helped cover the cost of office overhead. Now, to keep trip prices down we have started using 47 participants to determine the trip price. This makes the viability of trips fragile. We have no margin to run a trip that will lose money.

We have had to increase our administration fee, which covers about 40% of our cost to run the office. Office operations include rent, payroll, insurance, telephone, mailing labels and office supplies. The balance of money needed to cover operations comes from donations, grants, gifts, estate gifts, gifts from IRA's (Required Minimum Distributions), fundraisers, and corporate sponsorships etc.

We are surveying participants in March and April to determine how Theater Bus should handle these situations. We are eager to hear from you. Please understand it may be necessary to cancel trips if we do not have a minimum of 47 participants, so we are encouraging you to bring a friend along on trips, and know we continue to work for and seek out affordable trips.



## Participant Policy

In order to assure a safe and pleasant experience for all participants, those attending our trips must be mobile and able to perform, without assistance, activities of daily living which include boarding and exiting the bus as well as navigating the venues, restaurants, bathrooms, boat docks etc. We cannot accommodate wheelchairs. Some trips may not be advisable for those with mobility issues requiring a walker. All coach buses have storage space and one seat for each passenger. If you take up more than one seat, you must pay for a second seat. We retain the right to refuse service to anyone exhibiting what we consider to be unacceptable behavior.

## Cancellation Policy

Your request for a refund must be received prior to the deadline date for the trip. Refunds will be issued for refundable expenses only, less a \$17 administrative fee. After the deadline date, you may find a replacement to fill your spot. Please let us know who that person will be. If you are unable to find a replacement and there is a wait list for the event, Theater Bus may be able to assign a substitute and issue you a refund less the administrative fee.

## Instructions for Completing the Reservation Forms

*Note: Some events fill well before the deadline. If more than two weeks have gone by after the bulletin mailing, please call the office before registering to ensure that there is still space available. Register early to ensure that you have a space. Registrations will not be taken over the telephone or spaces held unless payment has been received.*

1. Select the form for the event you wish to attend. Please complete providing the following information:
  - **Name and address**—Please use a return address label if you have one to ensure that we capture your information accurately. Otherwise, print your name and address clearly.
  - **Telephone number**—Your phone number is necessary in case we have questions. Our volunteers will call you prior to the event to confirm your attendance, pickup location and time. Please provide Emergency Contact name and phone number.
  - **Number attending**—If you are registering just yourself, enter “1.” If you are registering more than one person, write the number attending and then write the name, address, phone number, pickup location, and meal choice, if required, of any others attending on the reverse side of the form.
  - **Additional contribution**—As a nonprofit organization, we provide scholarships for participants in need. We depend upon donations to keep costs down and to include everyone. Thank you so much!
  - Indicate your preferred **pickup location**. Please be at the pickup location 15 minutes prior to the designated time.
  - If you wish to sit with a **friend** or group of friends, indicate the name(s) on line 4.
  - If you have special dietary needs, please call the office **in advance** to make accommodations.
  - If **meal selections** need to be made prior to the event, please indicate your meal preference on the form.
2. Theater Bus accepts checks, but not credit cards, as **payment**. **Separate checks should be written for each event**, although you may include registration fees for more than one person attending a single event on a single check. Checks should be made payable to **Theater Bus**.
3. **Mail** your registration form(s) and payment to: **Theater Bus, Inc., 437 S. Yellowstone Dr. #214, Madison, WI 53719** (Please note that we do not notify you of our receiving your reservation, but you can call to verify. Your cancelled check is your confirmation.)

*Note: All tips are included in the cost of the trip, to include a tip for the bus driver and wait staff.*

**Please bring your cell phone on a trip and keep it turned on. Silence the ringer during theater performances. There are times in which we may need to contact you before a trip, during a trip, or after a trip.**


